Access, Toilets and Decorating: as I said last Sunday I had a visit from Martin Ingham who is recommended by the diocese and is going to co-ordinate all the work. The toilet will be where the second confessional is (due to where the drains are) with one bench being removed on each side of the church to allow access.
